
OUR WEEK AT OSHC

This week the children enjoyed a variety of indoor and outdoor activities as well as fun craft. In the mornings, skylanders was a popular game chosen by the children. They played against each other and the staff as they battled the elements of wind, water, fire and earth. Play dough was another fun activity we enjoyed in the mornings. Some children used the play dough tools to create coloured pasta while others used the shapes to cut out animals. Lego is always a favourite activity chosen by the boys in particular, however this week they took inspiration from the franchise 'angry birds' while building their fortress. They created obstacles using the Lego that would typically be seen in the game.

During the afternoons the children love to go outside to play a variety of sports.
