
OUR WEEK AT OSHC

This week Chess has been a popular activity played by the students. Older children in particular have been teaching younger students how to play and tested their knowledge by quizzing them on the names of each piece. The dinosaur activity pack was spread out in the office on multiple days. Students created their own version of a theme park that had dinosaurs roaming the land and even formed groups that were responsible for each 'land' in the theme park.

Wet weather prevented a large amount of outdoor play this week however we made the most of the sunlight and dry weather when possible. On Thursday afternoon the children used the Frisbees and created their own competition. They stood in a line 10m back from the goal posts and tried to throw the Frisbees in-between the soccer goals. This was a fun activity that included all students from different years.

Taking inspiration from the wet weather, the children drew pictures using folded paper to create a 3D umbrella. Students were able to make their umbrella any size or pattern of their choosing.
