This week we've really enjoyed playing outdoors with one another. Our favourite game at the moment is AFL!

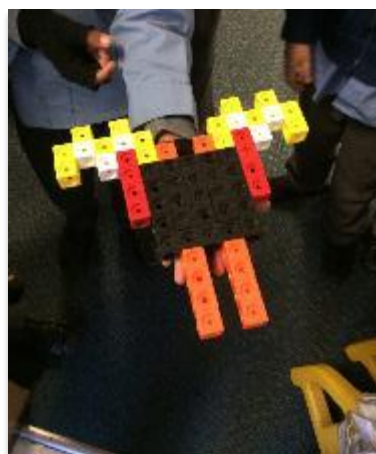


We have been experimenting with different ways to paint. We used small spray bottles to create cool effects on paper.
